

Have a look at Hansard, a website that records everything that is said in Parliament





Read written questions and answers from Members of Parliament to different ministers

Finding out more detailed information on government policies and activities and identifying which MPs may have asked a question on your issue

of the work gets done e.g. the
Health Select Committee
